The Access Project, Rwanda

- *District Health Administration:* Fellows serve as technical advisers to 12 health centers in Ngoma District on 8 areas ranging from infrastructure to finances to mutuelles.

Elizabeth Glaser Pediatric AIDS Foundation, Malawi

- *Monitoring and Evaluation:* Managed quality control efforts on PMTCT data, and assist with data collection and analysis for donor reporting.

Covenant House, USA

- *Health Counseling:* Fellows work as health counselors for the homeless teenage residents of Covenant House in Newark, NJ. They conduct physical wellness assessments to identify emergent and chronic health conditions, develop case management plans, provide prevention education, and help residents follow up on their healthcare needs.

Clinton Health Access Initiative, Uganda

- *Public-Private Partnerships:* Engaged private sector to help drive uptake of severe antimalarials, prepare for the rollout of HIV viral load testing, and increase second line ARV optimization.

Dignitas International, Malawi

- *Electronic Medical Records Programming:* Fellows help to manage the roll-out of a new EMR system district-wide and to create new EMR modules as needed.

Infectious Diseases Institute, Uganda

- *Distance Learning:* Fellows are working with the IDI Information Services team to define and evaluate the requirements for IDI to host an e-learning platform for its clinical training materials. They also work with IDI's Curriculum Development Team to create content suitable for "e-learning on demand."

Inter-American Development Bank, USA

- ***Social Protection and Health:*** Fellows work with economists and specialists who are leading health projects across MesoAmerica. This includes analyzing health data to establish country epidemiological profiles, designing interventions tailored to address public health challenges, and supervising the implementation of these interventions.

- ***Management Consulting:*** Fellows assess best practices in clinical operations management and create franchising training products that deliver these best practices across the franchisee network.

Centre for Infectious Disease Research, Zambia

- ***Resource Development:*** Produced videos, online course content, branding and website to raise awareness and provide educational tools around cervical and breast cancers for service providers, government officials and the general public throughout Africa.

- ***Supply Chain and Procurement:*** Fellows work to ensure that necessary equipment and material support was provided for operations in PIH Rwanda's three partner districts. Their work included improving procurement systems for the organization, following up on donated equipment, and managing the procurement of medical equipment for a new district hospital.

- ***Research:*** Performed research to support priority health policy and programmatic decisions, including preventing mother-to-child transmission of HIV and early infant diagnosis for pediatric HIV care.
